The Experience

Join Salem State University professors Stephen Matchak and Christopher Mauriello to study the history and geography of World War II. After three intensive days of classes studying the war in Europe, we will travel to the following WWII sites:

- Paris, France (Paris walking tour, monuments, optional visit to Les Invalides)
- Bastogne, Belgium (Bastogne Historical Centre, guided tour of Battlefield, Patton Memorial)
- Luxembourg City, Luxembourg (American WWII cemetery)
- Remagen, Germany (Remagen Bridge and Peace Museum)
- Nuremburg, Germany (Nazi Documentation Center, Rally Grounds, Palace of Justice)
- Dresden, Germany (Military History Museum of the FRG, Dresden City Museum)
- Potsdam, Germany (Cecilienhof Castle-site of Potsdam Conference)
- Berlin, Germany (Berlin walking tour, Jewish Museum Berlin, German Historical Museum, Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe)

Walking tours include: battlefields, museums, cemeteries, memorials, historic sites, art, architecture, and urban geography. We will also have plenty of time to explore the diversity of music, food and culture in larger and smaller cities and towns. Students and teachers from many disciplines are welcome.

The institute has an interdisciplinary approach that includes many of the liberal arts and meets many of the Massachusetts educational frameworks for history and social studies.

Credit available includes 3 or 6 undergraduate, 3 or 6 graduate, or up to 45 PDP's in geography, history or education.

Course Information

Note: The trip is a required component of the institute and must be taken to receive credit or PDPs for this institute. Students must complete three days of seminar-style institute classes before departure. These sessions will use multimedia presentations, readings and discussion to explore the history and geography of World War II. In addition, these sessions will review the academic requirements and due dates for institute portfolio and the travel aspects of the seminar.

Dates of class are: July 5, 6 and 7. The travel portion of the institute is from July 8-19. All students must attend all days of the study/travel institute classes to receive credit. Travelers joining the trip but not taking the institute for credit are welcome to attend the seminars.
