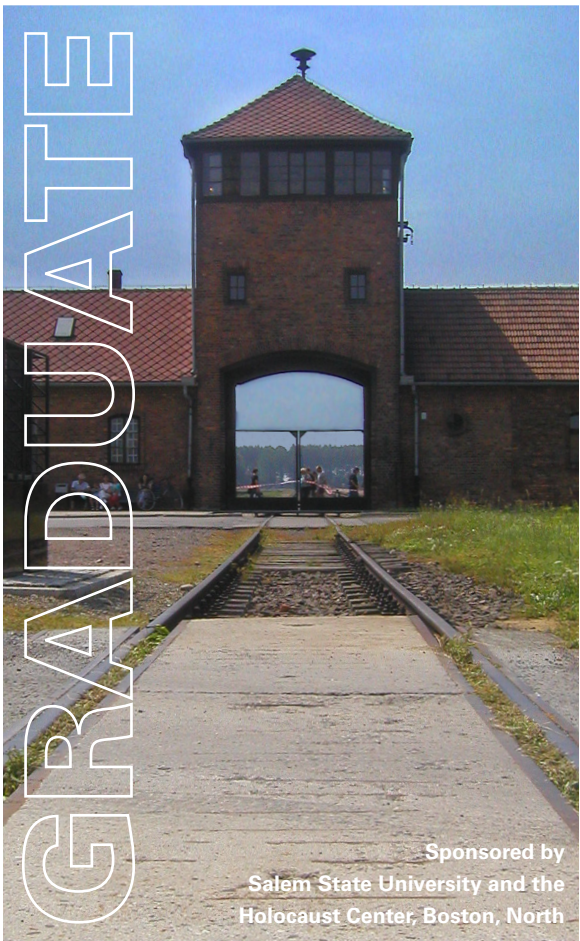

The Experience

Join Salem State University history professor Christopher Mauriello for a unique and affordable study and travel institute on the history of the Holocaust in Poland. The institute includes three intensive Saturday sessions at Salem State University. Following these institute classes, we will travel as a group to Poland to explore:

- Warsaw (tours of the Jewish Ghetto, Warsaw Uprising, monuments, and museums)
- Kielce (Kielce Pogrom Monument)
- Auschwitz (Auschwitz I Camp and Museum, Auschwitz II Camp)
- Krakow (Tours of the Jewish Ghetto, Jewish Museum, monuments, and museums)



Co-sponsored by Salem State University and the Holocaust Center, Boston, North, this study and travel institute is designed for K-12 teachers, graduate students and members of the public interested in teaching and learning about the Jewish life and culture in Poland, the Holocaust and World War II.

With three Saturday classes, travel during the Massachusetts April school vacation week and priced reasonably for five days in Poland, the institute was designed to fit the schedules and budgets of most of our participants. In addition to visiting historic sites in Poland, we will have plenty of time to explore the diversity of music, food and culture in Poland's two largest and most historic cities, Warsaw and Krakow. Students, teachers and the general public from all disciplines and backgrounds are welcome.

Participants who want to receive credit can register for three or six undergraduate or graduate history credit from Salem State or up to 45 PDP's in history for recertification. A submitted and graded study and travel portfolio will be required for credit. Contact Professor Mauriello for more information on this option.

Course Information

Note: The trip is a required component of the institute and must be taken to receive credit or PDPs for this institute. Students must complete three Saturdays (February 5, March 5 and April 9; 9 am - 2 pm) of seminar-style institute classes before departure. The travel portion of the institute is from April 15-21. All students must attend all days of the study/travel institute classes to receive credit. Travelers joining the trip but not taking the institute for credit are welcome to attend the institute classes.
